## **Device pairing**

- 1. Turn on the Bluetooth from iPad/Smart Phone.
- Turn on the BRC-100 power and press the "CONN" button. (Please make sure the red LED is flashing)
- The device "Bluetooth Remote controller" displays on iPad/Smart Phone. Then, choose "Connect".
- 4. Start to use BRC-100.
- Note: 1. Please press any key to re-establish the connection between BRC-100 and iPad/Smart Phone after turning the Power Switch On.
  - 2. There is a power switch at back of the BRC-100. When not in use, please turn to OFF to save battery power.
